This 6 week course will focus on teaching established ASL interpreters, to become DeafBlind interpreters. You will be taught the DeafBlind culture, different vision losses, communicating with DeafBlind people through different mode of communications, Pro Tactile, guiding, the Do's and Don'ts while working with DeafBlind people.

This class will help you improve interpreting skills, and increase experience and knowledge of how to work with DeafBlind people. During the 6 week session, we will have a guest speaker, watch videos, and do some role-playing.
